WELCOME TO BRIGHTER DAYS 2023

Welcome to the 2023 Brighter Days Festival.

Here we are back together again in beautiful Bright for our 11th year.

Each year our dedicated committee starts our planning with a debrief on the previous year; what worked, what didn't and what we can do differently, and this is how Brighter Days continues to go from strength to strength each year. And now here we are ready to go again in March 2023.

I believe we have come up with something everyone can be proud of this year, and we invite you to really get involved in everything on offer and enjoy what promises to be a sensational event.

The Brighter Days Foundation gave away \$825,000 after the 2022 event which makes an incredible total of over \$3.3 million we have given away over the Brighter Days journey.

Just as the work of the Brighter Days Foundation continues, so does the important work of our charities and I'm pleased to share with you the great progress that has been made over the last year.

The Cooper Trewin Foundation SUDC have given away 360 Safe Sleep packs to the Bairnsdale Hospital plus a pledge for \$200,000 AUD to the Boston Children's Hospital and The Harvard Medical School for the Cooper Trewin Zebra Fish trial that they are running. This trial is continuing with some good results to be published soon.

DEBRA has seen an increase in new families needing support with nine babies born with EB in the past 12 months which adds to the help that is required. DEBRA has increased nursing hours by 8% so that nurses have extra capacity to care for children and adults living with EB. This is all in addition to their research initiatives.

EB Research Partnership (EBRP) Australia has invested heavily in research and in 2021 funded 13 innovative research projects with the potential to heal all subtypes of EB across six countries. They have prioritised funding projects that could be in the hands of patients in the next 1-4 years which will significantly improve the quality of lives for all EB sufferers.

We would like to congratulate and acknowledge all the hard work and long hours of the nurses, carers, researchers and doctors who are involved across all levels of research programs or with general day to day care; what an awesome job they do.

All of you here this weekend or those who have been here in the past have all greatly contributed to the progress we are making around the world with our research partners, so give yourself a pat on the back. Without your generosity, your donations and your support none of this would be possible.

On behalf of the entire committee thank you for your ongoing support.

The Brighter Days Foundation was formed in 2012 to offer support to two charities; the DEBRA Foundation (Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa Research Association) and SUDC (Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood). Through a friend, whose child had been diagnosed with the debilitating EB disease, the band the Smokin' O'Briens played a backyard EB awareness gig where they met sufferers Eliza and Tilly.

So touched by the plight of these children, musicians Matt Powell, John Nixon and Steve Dundon decided to do something more to help. At the same time their bike-riding buddy Jim Henwood's close friends Rob and Kylie Trewin had lost their son Cooper to SUDC whilst another great mate and Bright local Jason Reid was experiencing first hand the trauma of a very sick child.

Collectively the guys wanted to do something that would make a real difference to those suffering.

They put their heads together and drew on the significant resources of their wider circle of friends who were also motorcycle and car enthusiasts and so the Brighter Days Foundation began.

With the festival now in its 11th year, we are proud to have donated over \$3.3 Million to our charities, a figure we could not have imagined when we started in 2013.

DEBRA AUSTRALIA

DEBRA Australia is a not-for-profit volunteer-based organisation that does not receive any direct Government funding and works tirelessly to support those living with a rare skin blistering disease called Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB)

EB is a rare disease whereby the skin blisters and peels at the slightest touch. Living with EB has been likened to living with third degree burns. It is very painful, and sufferers must be bandaged every day with dressings to protect and medicate their wounds. Recent estimates suggest more than 1200 people currently live with EB in Australia, and more than 500,000 people worldwide.

DEBRA Australia assists in improving the lives of children and adults living with EB by providing necessary support services, medical supplies, aids and equipment, assistance with transition to independent living and research focusing on different aspects of EB.

In addition to this DEBRA delivers a number of programs to support and educate families living with EB as well as hosts seminars to train and educate specialist



health professionals and nurses. DEBRA Australia also works with DEBRA International to provide support for EB families worldwide and aims to facilitate opportunities for EB research to find approaches to cure and develop therapies for EB.



Our vision is a world where no one suffers from the painful genetic skin condition Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB).

For more than 10 years, Brighter Days has supported the work of DEBRA Australia and has become one of DEBRA Australia's most valued partners. Since its inception in 2013, The Brighter Days Foundation has donated more than \$1.1 Million to support our programs and all our EB families and we are truly thankful for The Brighter Days Foundation. EB RESEARCH FOUNDATION

When Tilly Wilkes was born with Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) in Melbourne in 2011, it turned her family's world upside down. The Wilkes family had never heard of EB and to learn of the painful and cruel life their daughter was about to face was devastating. Business leader, Scott Didier AM, heard of Tilly's story and with friends established the EB Research Foundation, now the EB Research Partnership (Australia) to raise significant funds to invest into science and research to find a cure for Epidermolysis Bullosa.

EB is a family of rare genetic disorders that affect the body's largest organ: the skin. Individuals with EB lack critical proteins that bind the skin's two layers together. Without these proteins, the skin tears apart, blisters, and shears off leading to severe pain, disfigurement, and wounds that may never heal.

EB is a devastating disease. It affects kids from birth. But what makes this cause different is we believe we can actually do something about it in our lifetime.



The support of Brighter Days helps to us to fund innovative research projects across the world, accelerating cuttingedge technology with potential to heal all forms of EB. We prioritise funding for projects

that can be in the hands of patients within 1-4 years and will lead to significantly improving the quality of lives of those living with EB or can be curative.

Our model and the research we fund can advance cures beyond EB for the 7,000 rare diseases that affect 400 million people around the world.

With the support of Brighter Days finding a cure for EB is not an if. it's a when.

COOPER TREWIN MEMORIAL SUDC RESEARCH FUND

The Cooper Trewin Foundation was established after the tragic passing of Cooper Trewin on 6 February 2010, aged 16 months.

Cooper passed for no known reason and the foundation was established to support research into the cause of sudden and unexplained death in children.

As a parent who is told by a pathologist after an autopsy that we had a healthy little boy without sickness, injury or disease leaves a lot of unanswered questions. We decided to establish research to try and help find a cause.

Cooper's connection to Brighter Days comes via committee members Jim & Lisa Henwood who heard Cooper's Dad talk at an event, deciding at that very moment to make a difference and help save other families from this same tragedy.

From its humble beginnings, we have been part of this incredible event. We have proudly watched Brighter Days grow into the iconic Australian festival it is today, achieved by the hard work of countless volunteers.

Money raised from Brighter Days has been directly credited with saving children lives, assisting the development of the Cooper Trewin Brighter Days Neuroimaging Study, Brighter Days Genetic Screening and a Safe Sleep Program run out of the Bairnsdale Hospital.

Our long term relationship with the Boston Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School currently has us committed to a \$400,000 genetic study utilising Zebrafish.

We are making a difference and Cooper is helping to change the world with this research.

"The incredible generosity of Dot and Tony really helped us to get back on track and move forward after the impact of the pandemic over the last couple of years. From the executive to the broader committee and all the volunteers this amazing announcement on the Sunday night after the presentation, really lifted everyone's spirits after a tough lead up to the event, with COVID uncertainty still in the air on top of being unable to run the event at all the year before."

"Our goal as a collective has always been to raise more funds each year, year in year out. We never want to go backwards, however for the first time due to COVID we did and we were all absolutely overwhelmed and stoked by this donation from Dot and Tony", said Brighter Days Vice President Jason Reid

'We watch how hard this committee works to raise funds for their very worthy charities" said LITE Guard Trench Shoring owners Dot and Tony. "We know that all funds raised go to the right places. This foundation is transparent and extremely hard working. While the presentation was on during the Sunday night, we looked at each other and agreed that this was the right thing to do. We are not overly wealthy people and we have worked bloody hard for every dollar we have ever made but we knew we would get real bang for our donated bucks, and it was our way of helping everyone who volunteers so much to provide a novel way of raising funds. We did this for the kids and our hope is that others will follow our lead."

From everyone involved in Brighter Days and from the charities we support, thank you Tony and Dot, from the bottom of our hearts. This was an amazing gesture, and we will make every effort to give LITE guard Trench Shoring the exposure it so clearly deserves because of your generosity.

JAMES REYNE

His songs have provided the soundtrack to endless Australian summers.

James Reyne is one of our finest singers and songwriters, responsible for iconic songs such as 'Reckless', 'The Boys Light Up', 'Beautiful People', 'Lakeside', 'Daughters Of The Northern Coast', 'Fall Of Rome', 'Hammerhead', 'Motor's Too Fast' and 'Slave'.

Distinctly Australian – as legendary critic Ed Nimmervoll noted, "His voice is as familiar to us as the taste of Vegemite, as essentially Australian" – James was inducted into the ARIA Hall of Fame in 1996 and was honoured with the Order of Australia (OAM) in 2014.

James has had 19 Top 40 singles – including six Top 10 hits – and 11 Top 10 albums. And his songs have been



covered by a range of artists, including Paul Kelly, John Farnham, Mick Thomas and Angie Hart.

James' latest album, Toon Town Lullaby, is his 12th solo studio album. "Another fine record, which sits comfortably in his classic catalogue" (Rhythms magazine).

THE SCREAMING JETS

The Screaming Jets have been an enduring rock force in the Australian music landscape for over 3 decades.

Before they had even signed their first record deal, The Screaming Jets had already clocked up more than 200 live shows, won the 'Triple J Battle Of The Bands' competition and established themselves as an onstage, no holds barred, powerhouse of Aussie rock n roll.

It was the band's second single 'Better' from their debut album 'All for One' that introduced the band to the world, and saw The Screaming Jets embark on their first world tour – to Europe, UK, USA & Canada.

Since then the band have kept their peddle to the metal, releasing 9 studio albums (4 of them Top 5 on the Australian ARIA Charts), scoring multiple gold and platinum records & notching up literally thousands of gig and touring miles under their belt.

Affectionately known as Australia's 'Last Great Pub Rock Band', the Jets live show never disappoints, and as a result they have built a devoted, die-hard live fan base across Australia and the world.



From their humble beginnings in Newcastle, New South Wales in 1989, their 30 plus years in the Oz music biz has not slowed down The Screaming Jets and their hunger to make great rock music and entertain their fans.

KATE CEBERANO

Fronting pop funk band 'I'm talking', Kate notched up 5 consecutive hit singles and a platinum debut album 'Bear Witness'. The year was 1986 and Kate won Most Popular Female Artist at the Countdown Awards.

Kate has barely drawn breath since, racking up 28 albums over 35 years whilst effortlessly moving around genres. Notching up 13 X Platinum status, 8 X Gold, 4 x ARIA awards and 19 nominations, and dozens of other major awards, Kate is Australian entertainment royalty. She performed across the country in the legendary Australian Made tour with INXS and Jimmy Barnes, starred in Jesus Christ Superstar with John Farnham, South Pacific for Opera Australia at the Sydney Opera House, had her own tonight show 'Kate Ceberano & Friends' on the ABC TV, won Dancing With The Stars, first Australian woman inducted into the Australian Songwriters Association (ASA) Hall of Fame in 2014. awarded Order of Australia in 2016 for services to the arts and charity, curated the Adelaide Cabaret Festival for three record breaking years, just to name a few of her milestones.



Kate Ceberano is a most diverse and creative tour-deforce. A bona fide national treasure, possessing one of the great voices of her generation.

Long may she run.

The latest album Sweet Inspiration hit # 5 on ARIA album chart. This puts Kate in the pantheon of ARIA artists, with Top 10 albums across 5 decades; 80's, 90's, 00's, 10's and now 2020's... joining AC/DC, Kylie Minogue and Midnight Oil for this honour.

ELLA HOOPER

Ella Hooper was still a teenager when she burst onto the Australian music scene – Unearthed by Triple J when she was just 13, Ella scored her first number one with the single 'Mascara' on her 17th birthday. And at 18, she became the first woman to be awarded APRA's Songwriter of the Year.

After releasing three hit albums with Killing Heidi, Ella embarked on a solo career. Her forthcoming album, Small Town Temple – written in her hometown of Violet Town – has been hailed as a new beginning, showcasing Ella's deeply personal songwriting.



After a multitude of gold and platinum records and four ARIA Awards, Ella remains committed to her craft.

As she sings on Small Town Temple: "Still strong, still on a mission."

RICHARD CLAPTON

Richard Clapton as one of Australia's foremost singer/ songwriters, paved the way for subsequent generations of songwriters to write about the experience of being Australian.

He grew up in Sydney in the 1960s. He wrote a first album, Prussian Blue (1973) in Germany which was one of the first major Australian "singer-songwriter" albums.

One of the most popular songs from Prussian Blue was I Wanna Be A Survivor and how true that message would turn out to be. His songs are still omnipresent on the radio to this day; his records charting the political landscape of the nation and the turbulent lives of two generations.

Richard Clapton has developed a sound based on melodic rock while his lyrics were poetic musings on his state of mind or the state of the nation.

By 1975, when he released his highly acclaimed, No.1 hit Girls On The Avenue, Clapton had set the themes he was to explore for the coming decades.

Over the following years there were a string of hits including the perennial favourites: Capricorn Dancer, Deep Water, I Am An Island, and many more.



He has released over 20 albums which have cumulatively sold over one million copies.

In 1999 he was inducted into the ARIA Hall of Fame and in 2014, his first memoir "The Best Years of Our Lives" was published by Allen and Unwin.

In 2021 Richard released his first cover album, entitled Music Is Love (1966-1970). A timely homage to the music of peace love & understanding; tunes of the American hippies from the late 1960's.

MAHALIA BARNES

Mahalia Barnes has been in and around music her entire life. Throughout her childhood years she was exposed to everything from Mahalia Jackson, Ray Charles, Otis Redding, Wilson Pickett + Sam Cooke to Ike + Tina Turner, Aretha Franklin, Donny Hathaway and Stevie Wonder, all of which helped shape her into the powerhouse soul and blues vocalist that has jaws dropping every time she picks up a mic. Mahalia and her band, The Soul Mates, have released three full length albums as well as several EPs and consistently play to capacity crowds around the country. They have toured nationally and internationally supporting artists such as Bruce Springsteen, The Roots,



Mavis Staples, Joe Bonamassa, Bryan Adams, Tom Jones and more. Mahalia is also an in demand session vocalist and live backing vocalist, having recorded and toured with the likes of Joe Bonamassa, Liam Gallager, George Benson, Robert Jon + The Wreck, Cold Chisel, Jimmy Barnes and Lachy Doley to name a few.

The Brighter Days Festival is a family-friendly event without age restrictions.

WHERE IS THE RESERVED SEATING?

Reserved seating is at the front behind the 'chair-free' area roped off for dancing.

HOW DO I PICK UP MY TICKET I BOUGHT ONLINE?

You will simply have your ticket barcode (printed or on your device) scanned and show your ID at the gate to collect your tamperproof wristband. You may then come and go from the festival precinct as you like. Please note: All patrons must be wearing a wristband to enter the precinct.

IS THERE FOOD AVAILABLE AT THE FESTIVAL?

The Brighter Days Festival Food Court will be operating all weekend, from Friday 4.00pm with a variety of food and drink options for all the family.


