





THE BIG WALK (MOUNT BUFFALO) A Hiker's Ultimate Challenge


For experienced hikers looking for a physically demanding but highly rewarding trek, The Big Walk at Mount Buffalo National Park is an unforgettable adventure. This 11km ascent takes you through diverse landscapes, including eucalyptus forests, rocky outcrops, and alpine meadows, before reaching the highest point in Mount Buffalo, The Horn (1,723m).

The trail features several breathtaking lookouts, including Mackey's Lookout and Marriotts Lookout, providing incredible panoramic views of the Ovens Valley. As you climb higher, the air becomes crisper, and the vegetation transitions from dense forest to open alpine terrain. The final stretch to The Horn Lookout rewards hikers with 360-degree views stretching across the Great Dividing Range, making the effort more than worthwhile.

This challenging hike takes around 4-5 hours one way, with the option to descend via car or shuttle for those not wanting to hike back down. The best times to attempt The Big Walk are autumn and spring, when the mild temperatures and seasonal colours enhance the journey. For those seeking a serious hiking challenge with some of Victoria's most breathtaking views, The Big Walk is a must-do experience.

Stretching from Wangaratta to Bairnsdale, this scenic highway passes through Bright, Mount Hotham, and the Alpine National Park, making it an epic long-distance ride.

Cyclists taking on the Bright to Mount Hotham section will experience:

- Winding mountain climbs A gradual but challenging ascent with sweeping hairpin bends.
- Stunning alpine scenery Ride through snow gums, rugged peaks, and breathtaking lookouts.
- High-altitude cycling The summit at Mount Hotham (1,861m) provides incredible panoramic views.

This ride is best suited to experienced road cyclists, as it includes steep climbs and unpredictable alpine weather conditions. Many riders train all year for this iconic ride, which is a highlight of the annual Tour of Bright race.

For those looking for a less intense but equally scenic ride, the Bright to Harrietville section of the Great Alpine Road offers a gentler gradient and stunning valley views, making it a great introductory alpine ride.

Bright CBD Map


